Heritage of Routes, Networks, and Connections: European Heritage Days (EHD) "highlight this year the inter-connections shaping Europe's rich and diverse heritage, from ancient routes and trade networks to modern digital links". The initiative, jointly promoted by the Council of Europe and the European Union, kicks off this week, involving over 40 countries.
