
EU Parliament: plenary session in Brussels. Victims in the Mediterranean, Israeli-Palestinian conflict, relations with Turkey

Earlier today, day two of the plenary session of the European Parliament (17-20 May) opened with a debate about the national recovery plans, especially the role of Parliament, which, in a resolution that will be voted on next Wednesday, is asking to be adequately informed about the national plans and their progress through the EU Commission. The second item on the agenda is the European industrial strategy and a debate about the European Commission's latest proposals put forward to Parliament by Commissioner Margarethe Vestager to stimulate economic recovery by strengthening the European industrial base.
